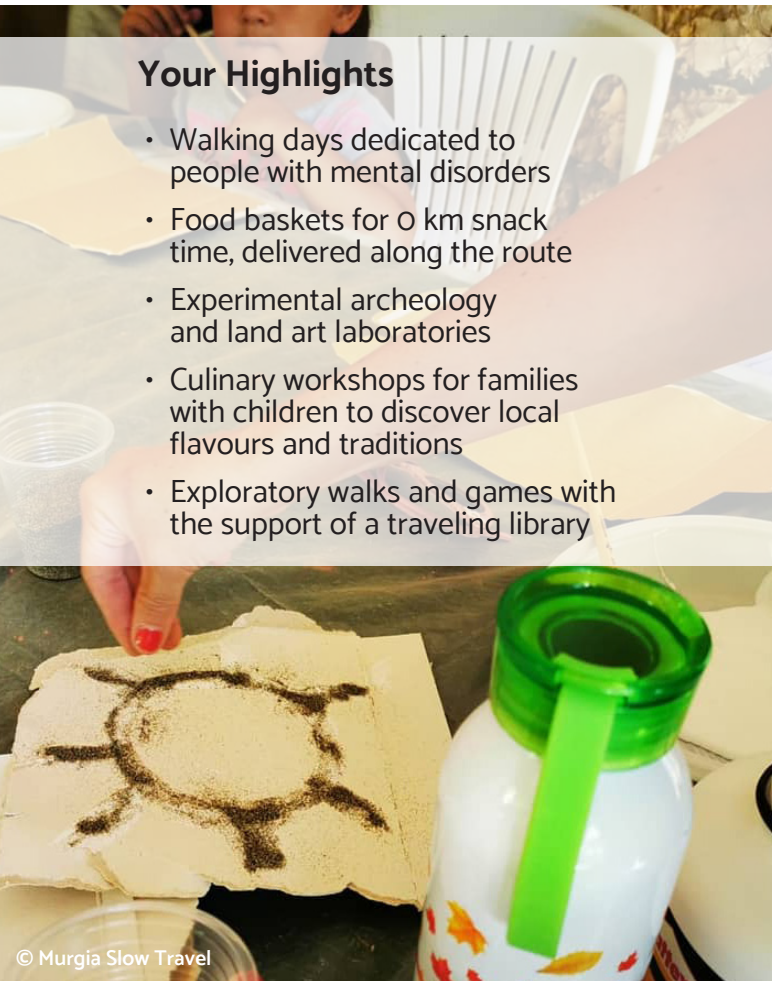

Enjoy the Via Francigena route, in the direction of Via Traiana, within the municipalities of Ostuni and Carovigno. To facilitate the fruition of themed itineraries and excursions by people with motor disabilities, personalized tourist services have been made available or suitable vehicles, such as hand bikes, electric two-seaters, electric wheelchairs and boats. You will also find health and logistical assistance services to support guided tours for wheelchair users or for other specific health needs. In particular, the itineraries proposed are linked to the landscape heritage (coastal dunes and historic olive tree groves), to cultural heritage (old towns, museums, farms, dolmens), to material culture (olive tree cultivation), to food and wine traditions and to excursions on accessible boats.

Termoli Sotterranea is an archeological area, used as a museum, located in the underground spaces of the Bishop's Palace. The area is open to the public, with an entrance directly from Piazza Duomo. In it you can admire findings from the Basilica-Cathedral of great importance from a historical, liturgical and cultural point of view. From the hypogeum (the underground area) it is also possible to visit the cemetery area adjacent to the Basilica-Cathedral, discovered during the archaeological excavations of 1994. Termoli Sotterranea is accessible to everyone and the structure is complemented by an immersive room in which it is possible to discover the secrets of the site through different mediums, such as a tactile map and virtual tour with three-dimensional glasses.

Within the beach area you can also find an accessible bar and a completely accessible restaurant; the last one is particularly suggested also to have gluten free meals. Just outside the beach area you will be able to explore the surroundings thanks to an accessible pedestrian area fringed with numerous facilities also suited for people with motor disabilities.

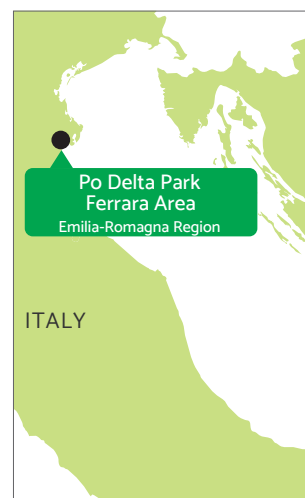

The Natural Park of Cervia is a green oasis of 32 hectares within the thousand-year-old pinewood: there's no better place to spend a day surrounded by nature for the carrying out of didactic, research and study activities and for the analysis of the pinewood ecosystem. This environment can be explored through guided paths with several didactic goals, such as the knowledge of the local tree and shrub species or the understanding of the main animal species of the place. In order to deepen the theme of biodiversity, the next stop-over in your itinerary could be the Butterfly House in Milano Marittima, a greenhouse of 500 sqm that reproduces the rainforest habitat and allows the flight of hundreds of tropical butterflies. The presence of an inclusive electric shuttle will allow families with special needs and people with disabilities to take part of the tour in order to make the destination fully accessible. If you're passionate about history and you're curious about how the Veneto region - so full of attractions nowadays - looked like in the past, then you should definitely take a tour of its amazing “Tactile” museums scattered all around the region. There you're going to find tactile maps which will make visually impaired people discover all about the ancient inhabitants of the area and be immersed in their everyday life.

In particular, in the Archaeological Museum of Fratta Polesine (Rovigo), you're going to discover the life of ancient populations living in the Po river area, while in the Atestino Museum of Este (Padova) you will be able to enjoy the history of ancient Venetians, who inhabited the region during the 1st Millennium B.C; in the second one, alongside the tactile maps you will also be given the chance to touch and appreciate reproductions of local finds.

While in the aforementioned museums you will have the opportunity to know more about ancient people inhabiting the area before the Roman era, in the Concordiense Museum of Portogruaro and in the National Museum and archaeological area of Altino you will be able to explore the history of Roman stay in the region; in the second one, you will be amazed by the breath-taking remains of the city of Altinum.

To complete your tactile tour, you could then spend a while around the astounding Venice where you're going to find several museums offering you the chance to experience their visit without the benefit of sight, such as: the Archaeological Museum of Venice, the Oriental Art Museum (MAOVe), the Giorgio Franchetti Gallery at Ca' d'Oro and the Museum of Palazzo Grimani, with its amazing collection of classical sculptures.

Already known for its fervid atmosphere and its characteristic beach clubs, the Veneto coastline is also a valid destination for a restful holiday by the sea accessible to everyone. In the region you will find in fact equipped beach clubs offering tourists -from families with babies on strollers, to visually impaired guests, to people with motor or intellectual disabilities- the chance to experience a wonderful day at the beach. They offer several types of facilities to ease the access to the beach and to make your stay as comfortable as possible, such as: side anti-slip walkways to lead you towards the shoreline, adjustable platforms and a variety of amphibian bathing chairs specially designed for people with reduced mobility and a beacon to guide visually impaired bathers. The beach clubs indicated to find such facilities are: Primavera Beach in Rosolina (RO), Stabilimento balneare Seven in Bibione (VE), Nemo beach in Jesolo Lido (VE), Villaggio S. Paolo in Cavallino-Treporti (VE), Mete Beach in Eraclea (VE), White Oasis-Green Oasis in Comparto 5/Comparto 8 Ponente Levante in Caorle (VE), Venezia Spiagge in Lido di Venezia (VE), Astoria Beach in Sottomarina (VE).

Alongside the physical impairments we also have succeeded in making the Villas accessible to other types of disabilities; in this regard in Villa Widmann Foscari (Mira - VE), Villa Foscari Negrelli Rossi (Stra - VE) and Villa Pisani (Stra - VE), located by the Brenta river, and Villa Contarini (Piazzola sul Brenta - PD), near Padova, you will find facilities, such as LIS guides or written materials, to overcome hearing impairments. Where these implementations have not been provided, you will have the chance to visit the place as well, thanks to trained operators specialized in LIS tours. Some of the Villas, such as Villa Widmann Foscari (Mira - VE) and Villa dei Vescovi (Torreglia - PD) have also been made accessible to people with intellectual disabilities, thanks to CAA guides. Moreover, if you want to take a complete and breath-taking tour, which also includes the visit of the Villas, you should then experience one of the boat itineraries downriver, aboard a ferry fully accessible to wheelchairs. On board, you can also be provided with guides for people with visual or hearing impairment.

Thanks to a new elevator installed at the Golden Gate, to a platform at the eastern entrance of the historic core (the Silver Gate of Diocletian's Palace) and to a platform and a ramp at the western entrance (within two passages from Republic Square to adjacent streets), the historic core of Split is now easily accessible to people with a reduced mobility. The new facilities are part of a new vision of the city that embodies making its already in place cultural spots and services accessible to everyone and promoting new social and cultural activities. The renewal involves different types of accessibility: in fact tactile maps have been installed in several cultural attractions, not only facilities to overcome architectural barriers. Moreover, the city of Split has made available for you a map with information about the accessibility of its historical and cultural facilities.

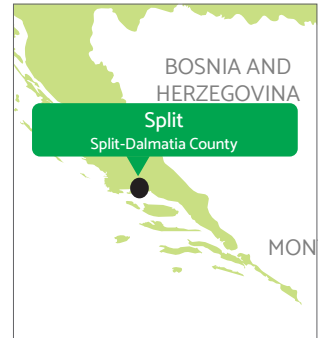

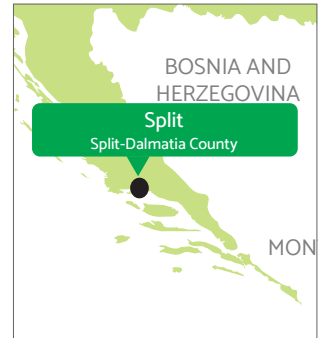

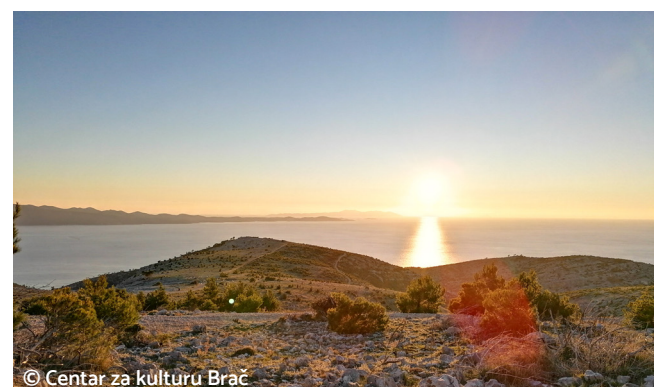
