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About Croatia...





Thanks to its location, Croatia is both a Central-European and a Mediterranean country. It has around four million inhabitants, and is bordered by Slovenia, Hungary, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia and Montenegro. Croatia has a long and diverse coastline giving onto the Adriatic Sea, with mountain ranges in its hinterland, and fertile plains in the northeast. Since 2013, Croatia has been a member of the European Union and as of 1 January 2023, it has adopted the euro (€) as its currency.

About Split...

Split is the second biggest city in Croatia, with close to 170,000 inhabitants. It's perfectly situated half way down the Dalmatian coast, which makes it a convenient base for trips to the islands, inland and along the coast. Split's history stretches back over 17 centuries, when Roman Emperor Diocletian chose to build his retirement palace on this site. During the centuries, the city grew up inside and around the biggest surviving ancient Roman imperial residence in Europe. **The result is a unique, living structure, which has been on UNESCO's World Heritage List since 1979.** You can travel through time as you stroll around this ancient city, while observing highlights of ancient architecture, such as the Peristil (peristyle), as well as medieval churches, Gothic palaces, the Renaissance facades of noble families' houses, all the way up to modern architecture, which has been carefully designed to blend into the historical environment.

Accommodation

Split has the capacity to host large events of all kinds. The Ultra Europe festival is an excellent example, when tens of thousands of music fans visit Split, and find suitable accommodation with ease. There are dozens of hotels of all categories, from large resort hotels, such as the Radisson Blu and Le Meridien Lav, to business hotels, such as the Atrium, AC Hotel by Marriott Split and the Art, to boutique hotels like Briig, Santa Lucia and Park. Split today has 18 hotels that are either four- star or five-star, and most of these have facilities for conferences, meetings and events.

In the city centre, within the walls of Diocletian's Palace (a UNESCO World Heritage site), there is a special category of accommodation: heritage hotels occupying historic buildings.

These small hotels offer tailored service, adjusted to suit their guests' needs and interests. Above all, this type of accommodation offers a unique way to experience Split's 1700-year-old heritage, where life has continued unceasingly from Ancient Roman times up to the present

day. Private accommodation, such as rooms and apartments, in historic parts of the city, offer a similar experience.

In total, Split offers cca 37,000 visitor beds, counting hotels, private accommodation, villas, hostels and other types of accommodation. In case of a higher demand, the nearby towns of Solin, Kaštela and Podstrana offer additional units. A full list is available through Visit Split.

Restaurants

Split has an excellent and diverse gastronomic scene, which has expanded in recent years, with a large number of restaurants opening in the city, especially in the historic centre and its surroundings. Several restaurants have been recognized by the world-famous Michelin Guide, such as Dvor, Fetivi, Kinoteka, Šug, Zoi, Zrno soli and Kadena.

However, there are many more worth visiting, where menus are generally based on local Mediterranean cuisine, occasionally with a creative twist added by some of Croatia's best chefs. As Split is well-supplied with primary ingredients, local restaurants can offer fresh well-prepared cuisine, notably seafood.

The most popular, and those with the most authentic local atmosphere, are the numerous "konoba", the Dalmatian version of a tavern, where you can enjoy first-class fish and other seafood, as well as some popular local meat dishes. It's hard to choose the best, but many people's favourites include Fetivi, Otprilike

Ovako, Matejuška, Hvaranin and Uje. On the other hand, there is a wide selection of more diverse international restaurants.

Besides those already mentioned, ones worth checking out are Bokeria, Corto Maltese, and Ma:Toni.

The local diet is rich in seasonal vegetables, which vegetarians can enjoy in regular restaurants, as well as eateries specializing in vegetarian and vegan fare. Wine and olive oil constitute an important part of local gastronomy, so Split's restaurants are well supplied with excellent Croatian wines, especially Dalmatian wines, and it is possible to arrange tasting parties. Some restaurants, such as Uje, offer regular olive oil tasting sessions.

Festivals / Events

Split is known for its music, film and theatre festivals. The oldest one is the **Split Summer Festival**, staging drama, opera, ballet and classical music at various venues, notably atmospheric open-air spaces in and around the old town. The Split Summer Festival is organized by the Croatian National Theatre Split.

Each year, Split hosts two international film festivals. Every June, large audiences flock to Bačvice open-air cinema and two other venues, to enjoy the **Mediterranean Film Festival Split**, which shows some of the most highly acclaimed films from the Mediterranean region, as well as from other parts of the world, in several separate programs.

All films are subtitled in Croatian and English, and every night you can enjoy a pleasant party after the main film. In September, the **Split Film Festival**

specializes in more artistic films, with various programs ranging from long and short features, to Croatian films and experimental works.

Split also hosts the **Split Music Festival**, with performances by Croatia's best-known pop stars, as well as several other music events, such as **Sustipan Nights Dream** in Sustipan Park, overlooking the city port. There is also the **Split Blues Festival**, and much more, including performances by folklore ensembles and klapa singers on the city's main squares and promenades during peak season.

The biggest music event is the annual **Ultra Europe festival**, which brings some of the best known international DJ's to Split, and thousands of party-loving people.

Every 7 May, the centuries-old celebration of Split's patron saint, **Saint Dominos**, takes place. Special events include a religious procession following a bust of the saint, an arts and crafts fair, a tombola, concert and fireworks. On the days around 7 May, many smaller events revoke bygone traditions, mostly in historic neighbourhoods such as Veli Varoš.

Throughout the year, but especially in spring and summer, Split hosts several culinary fairs and festivals, with some of the region's best producers and restaurants presenting local wines, olive oils and traditional food specialities. All announcements and schedules are available from the Tourist Board of Split.

The end of the year is marked by a traditional **Christmas Market**, taking place at various open-air venues, as well as at restaurants and bars around town. During this event, usually taking place from the beginning of December to the first week in January, you can enjoy local food, drinks, music and gifts, and traditional holiday celebrations unique to this part of Croatia.

As the sports capital of Croatia, Split is famous for hosting various sporting events. The most popular representative is HNK Hajduk football club - its matches are usually attended by thousands of passionate fans.



Museums/ Galleries

Split is the top cultural centre on the Croatian coast, with some of the country's most important museums and galleries. Besides permanent collections, most also host temporary exhibitions, as well as various events, such as concerts, theatre performances, conferences, and even parties and cocktails.

Guided Tours and Excursions

As it hosts various conferences and events, Split is also home to several PCO and DMC agencies, as well as travel and tour agencies. They provide qualified and professional staff, who will ensure that every event is well-organized and allows participants to achieve their goals. Besides being experts in events organisation, these agencies are also familiar with the local surroundings, attractions and customs, and opportunities for excursions and leisure activities, which can be added onto to the main event. They will ensure that events are enriched with local incentives, unforgettable for all participants and their guests.

There are also many agencies that can provide guided tours of Split and its surroundings, as well as day trips to the islands of Brač, Hvar, Vis, Šolta, Biševo (home to the Blue Cave) or Drvenik (with its Blue Lagoon), as well as nearby national parks and nature parks, and attractions on the rivers Krka and Cetina. Even Plitvice National Park is a possible day trip destination.

Outdoor activities, such as rafting and canyoning on the River Cetina, are very popular, as are visits to the medieval fortresses of Klis and Knin, and the ruins of the ancient Roman city of Salona. Other

options include hiking in the Dalmatian mountains, visits to caves, truffle hunting, and wine and olive oil tastings in Split and nearby. Split makes an excellent base for visiting some of Croatia's UNESCO World Heritage sites, such as Diocletian's Palace, Trogir, Stari Grad plain, and monuments in Šibenik and Zadar.

Guided tours are also available through direct contact with local guide associations, who provide the most reliable way to find licensed guides. Avoid tours given by self-titled guides without valid licenses – an official guide should have a blue identity card with her/his photo, and proof of license.

The Port of Split is situated on the Adriatic and is Croatia's largest passenger port. The Port of Split serves as the main hub for car ferries and catamarans to the Dalmatian islands of Brač, Šolta, Hvar, Korčula, Vis and Lastovo, as well as catamarans to the island of Mljet, and the city of Dubrovnik. In addition, there are international car ferries to Ancona in Italy. Schedule and ticketing are available through:

The Port of Split is the second busiest port in Croatia for large cruise ships, and the busiest of all for small cruise boats sailing around the Dalmatian islands between Split and Dubrovnik. The western part of the port offers berthing to private and rented yachts in the ACI Marina, and on the western Riva.

BY LAND

DRIVING

Split has excellent road connections to the rest of Croatia and the European countries beyond. The main route is the A1 motorway (aka Dalmatina), which is a toll road - prices and info are available through Croatian Motorways.

Split is also served by state, regional and local roads - the most important is the D8 Adriatic highway, which runs the length of

the Croatian coast.

TRAIN

Split is connected by train with Zagreb and the rest of Europe beyond. During peak season, there are direct trains from Osijek, Prague and Budapest.

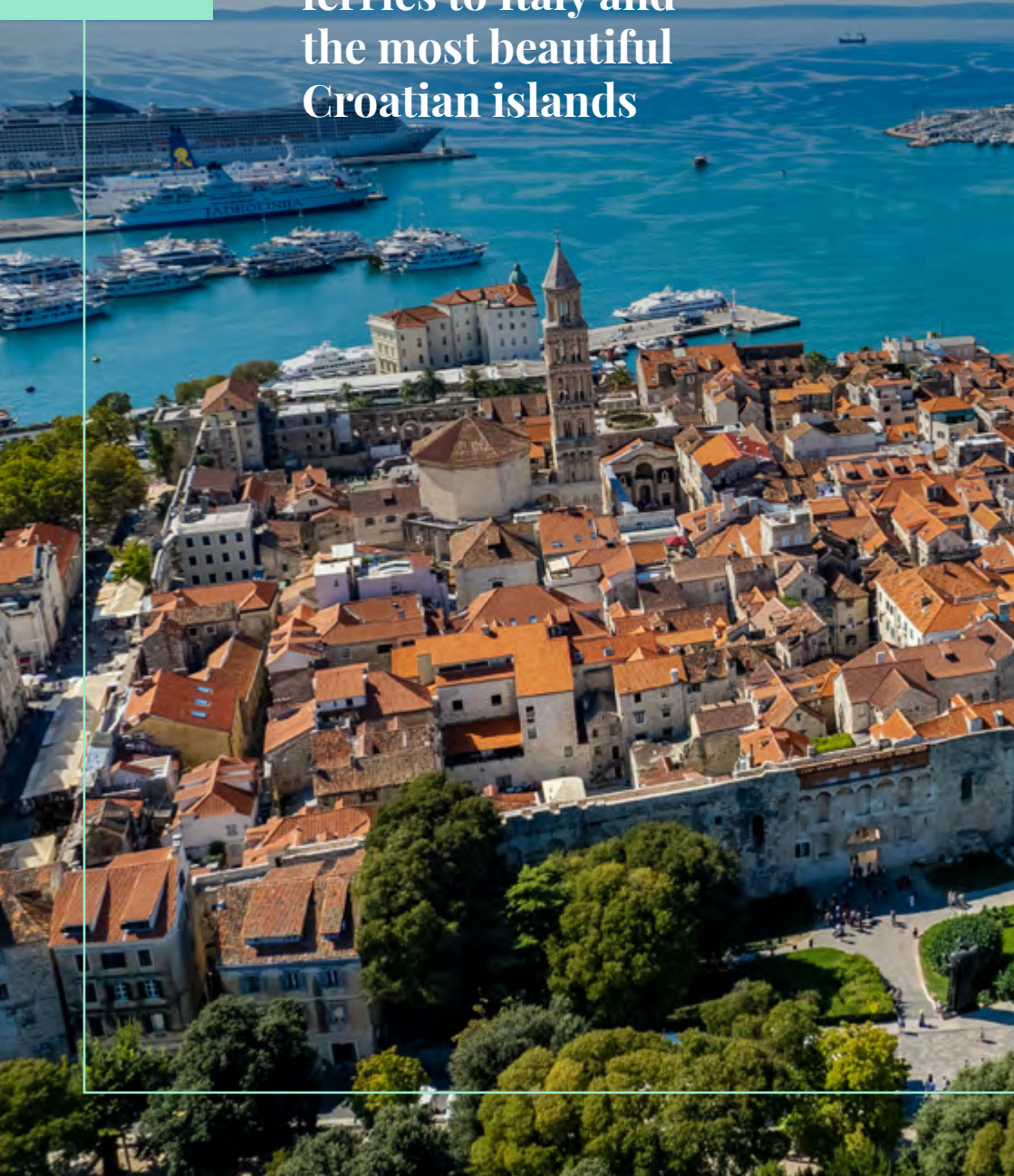
The main train station is located opposite the port, making it ideal for connections by ferry to the islands or by bus along on the coast. Info and ticketing for trains are available via Croatian Railways.

Venues

DIOCLETIAN'S PALACE BASEMENT HALLS

This is one of the best-preserved ancient complexes in Europe, and is a unique example of Ancient Roman architecture. When it was built, it served as the foundations of the palace's imperial residence, which stood above it. Its layout offers a glimpse of what the original plan of the residence looked like.

Due to their protected status, the basement halls are not suitable for events that could jeopardize their ancient heritage, but are a popular for wine fairs, flower shows, art exhibitions and theatrical performances, as well as for receptions during events in other places in Split. The halls are managed by the Split City Museum, which can provide all info on availability, capacity and type of events allowed. **Capacity: 250-300 persons buffet-style; 160 persons seated.**

SPLIT CITY MUSEUM

The Split City Museum occupies a complex of medieval and Renaissance-era buildings in the northeast section of Diocletian's Palace. The main part of the complex, to the east, is the Papalić Palace, where most of the exhibition rooms and storage spaces are located. The offices are in the southwest section. The museum has two courtyards within the complex, as well as a loggia overlooking the palace. For conferences and other similar events, this museum offers its Gothic Hall, complete with seating and audio-visual equipment. **Capacity: 100-130 persons buffet-style; 70 persons seated.**

MUSEUM OF CROATIAN ARCHEOLOGICAL MONUMENTS

The Museum of Croatian Archaeological Monuments is a modern building located close to the city centre and the main marina, at the foot of Marjan forest park,

with its natural and historical heritage and beaches. It houses some of the most important historical Croatian monuments and artefacts, particularly from the medieval Croatian state period. Its main hall is suitable for various events, ranging from conferences to receptions, with adjacent smaller rooms and halls for smaller events, or separate sub-events. All parts of the museum have A/C and offer easy access and nice views of the surrounding area. **Capacity for a gala dinner up to 80 persons.**

GALLERY OF FINE ARTS

The main atrium of the Gallery of Fine Arts is an open-air venue of almost 400 sqm. It is suitable for press conferences, marketing events, cocktails, gala dinners, lectures, and classic music and jazz concerts. The museum café is positioned within the gallery, with a terrace affording a unique view of Diocletian's Palace. The gallery also has a small theatre, and technical equipment for events in the gallery is available for rent. **Capacity: 50 persons seated; 150 persons buffet dinner style.**

CROATIAN NATIONAL THEATRE

The Croatian National Theatre is one of the pillars of Split's cultural life, with its regular repertoire of drama, opera, ballet and classical music performances. It also regularly hosts various events, ranging from conferences to corporate events and

other celebrations. The theatre's main hall, with its historic ambience and modern equipment, is perfect for such occasions. **The main hall has a capacity of 660, but the theatre also offers its foyer with up to 150 seats, or up to 350 standing guests. There is also a bar with catering.**

MEŠTROVIĆ GALLERY

The Meštrović Gallery hosts the masterpieces of Croatia's most famous, internationally recognised, artist Ivan Meštrović. The villa was built based on Meštrović's design (1931 – 1939) and was intended to be his family's summer residence, working studio and exhibition space. Set in a Mediterranean garden, with bronze sculptures and magnificent views over the sea and the islands of Central Dalmatia, it is a unique example of landscape architecture. **The central hall is appropriate for conferences, workshops and classical concerts, and has a capacity of up to 100 persons. The garden is suitable for cocktail parties and other receptions, and can accommodate up to 500 people.**

Only a minute's walk from the gallery, the Meštrović's Crikvine - Kaštilac is a church with beautiful cloister rimmed by columns where religious ceremonies take place, also designed by Meštrović himself.

VILLA DALMACIJA

Built in 2014. as a hotel, Villa Dalmacija has an interesting history. For a long time, it served as a summer residence

of lifelong Yugoslav president, Josip Broz Tito. Today, the villa is a city-owned diplomatic venue, but it is also available for all kinds of events, ranging from receptions and celebrations, to conferences in its main hall. Its location, by the sea, in a small secluded and isolated bay, provides the privacy needed for any event. It can be reached by road, or by boat on a short ride from the main city port. **The terrace has a capacity of up to 140 people, and the indoor hall can accommodate up to 140 people.**

POLJUD CONGRESS AND CATERING CENTRE

The Poljud Congress and Catering Centre is situated by the sea in the southwest part of Split. It overlooks a marina, and nearby are the city stadium, the Franciscan monastery, and the Church of Saint Anthony. The large hall seats up to 450 people, and there are six smaller halls, with capacities of 50 to 100. The banquet hall seats 350, and the terrace can accommodate up to 450 people. The centre's restaurant can provide catering for any events taking place there.

UNIVERSITY OF SPLIT

The University of Split has over 22,000 students, spread over eleven faculties, one arts academy and four university departments. It offers over 150 study programmes, in social sciences, humanities, natural, technical, biotechnical, medical, biomedical sciences

and arts. The offer is continuously being enriched with new, interesting and attractive study programmes. Besides the quality of its courses, and scientific and research activities, the University of Split has developed good international cooperation and is a partner to a number of international projects and programmes, and is a member of numerous international associations. The university hosts many conferences, scientific and otherwise, and has a total seating capacity of 5602, in new modern faculty buildings, mainly situated on the university campus or nearby. All available spaces are equipped with all the technology required for successful conferences and events. The university can also provide catering through its Students' Centre.

HRVATSKI DOM SPLIT

The Hrvatski Dom (Croatian Hall) is a newly renovated concert hall in the heart of Split, in a 19th-century building, which has always been one of the pinnacles of Split's cultural life. It has a large hall with a capacity of up to 250, with all the necessary audio-visual equipment. Its main purpose is to host concerts, mainly classical music and jazz. However, it makes a great venue for conferences, and the large atrium is suitable for breaks or even receptions.

MEDITERRANEAN INSTITUTE FOR LIFE SCIENCE

The Mediterranean Institute for Life Sciences (MedILS) is the Institute of Molecular Biology. Located on the hillside of Marjan, as part of the Villa Dalmacija complex, MedILS offers a unique setting for high-quality workshops and conferences, with multiple fully-equipped lecture rooms and halls. The institute has several fully-equipped halls, and a residential area to accommodate congress participants. MedILS lies a short walk or drive from Split's old town, which makes it easily accessible. At the same time, it's isolated from the city fuss, providing peace for events' attendants.
