Muški zbor Brodosplit

Founded in 1972, the Brodosplit Male Choir has become one of Croatia's most awarded amateur choirs. Its repertoire spans from Renaissance masters to contemporary composers, with a strong focus on Dalmatian musical heritage.

Mješoviti pjevački zbor INA

Founded in 1976, the INA Mixed Choir has performed internationally and collaborated with leading orchestras. Under conductor Bojan Pogrmilović it has performed more than 400 works and received numerous awards.

Ansambl Illyrica

An international chamber ensemble based in Croatia and Austria, Illyrica performs classical, folk-inspired and contemporary repertoire and is acclaimed for bringing new music to wider audiences.

Walter Romero i Diego 'Dipi' Kvitko

Walter Romero is a leading contemporary Argentine tango singer, while Diego 'Dipi' Kvitko is a renowned guitarist, composer and arranger. Together they present an authentic evening of Argentine tango.

Libercuatro

The programme 'Tango & Poetry' combines contemporary tango, Astor Piazzolla and the poetry of Pablo Neruda and Jorge Luis Borges. The ensemble actively promotes tango culture worldwide.

Kvartet flauta Image

The Image Flute Quartet was founded in 2013 and brings together flutists Marija Bašić Markotić, Mila Lapov, Ana Vrvilo and Antonia Mikas. The ensemble performs throughout Croatia and abroad, promoting Croatian musical heritage and contemporary repertoire.

Corina Marti i Michał Gondko

Corina Marti and Michał Gondko specialize in Renaissance instrumental music performed on historical instruments. Their programmes are based on scholarly research and historically informed performance practice.

Branimir Norac

Branimir Norac is a Croatian clarinetist and composer known for exploring the limits of the instrument and combining contemporary music, improvisation, traditional influences and electronic sounds.

Kvintet Aleph

The Aleph Quintet brings together experienced Split musicians led by flutist Ana Domančić Krstulović. The ensemble focuses on contemporary Croatian music and works by composers such as Boris Papandopulo and Anđelko Klobučar.

Trio – flauta, mandolina i čembalo

The ensemble consists of Marija Bašić Markotić, Ivana Kenk Kalebić and Borna Barišić. Their programme spans from Baroque to contemporary music and explores the unique colours of this instrumental combination.

Omiški barokni ansambl

The Omiš Baroque Ensemble is the only specialized Baroque ensemble south of Zagreb. It performs works by Croatian and European composers and promotes historically informed performance practice.
